## Resident Text Message Notification

We are looking at introducing a text message notification service to residents. This will allow a text message to be sent from Management to a resident mobile number in the event of an emergency or an important communication.

Examples could be, an emergency power outage advising residents of the details or an evacuation order from the SES in the case of flooding during a weather event.
